

Turn from the Devil (& towards prayer)

No sin is too small to hinder prayer, especially the sin of:

1. _____ This is possibly the greatest hindrance to prayer (. *But when he asks, he must believe and not doubt, because he who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind. That man should not think he will receive anything from the Lord; he is a double-minded man, unstable in all he does.* James 1:6–8).
2. _____ A full hand cannot take Christ's gifts. Pride prevents prayer, for prayer is a humbling thing. (*Delight yourself in the LORD and he will give you the desires of your heart.* Ps. 37:4).
3. _____ We cannot be wrong with men and right with God ("*Therefore, if you are offering your gift at the altar and there remember that your brother has something against you, leave your gift there in front of the altar. First go and be reconciled to your brother; then come and offer your gift.* Matt. 5:23–24).
4. _____ When we pray for the conversion of others, are we willing to be the means?
5. _____ How often our Lord refers to united prayer!
6. _____ - 1 Thessalonians 5:16–18 tells us to "*Be joyful always, pray continually, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.*"
