By Letter: This means transferring your letter (record of membership) from another Baptist church. We gladly attend to details of transfer.

By Baptism: This means that you have previously accepted Christ and have not been baptized by immersion. Upon joining HBC, we ask that you participate in baptism by immersion.

By Statement of Faith: This means that you have accepted Christ and have been baptized by immersion; however, membership records from another church are unavailable. Please feel free to contact our pastor for more information.
